Crisp, fresh White Wines

### 1 Sauvignon Blanc, Catamayor, 2008 Uruguay

£15.95

*Of great class, due to its typical and strong concentration, this is a unique wine that has one many awards in international competitions. The wine has a full bouquet of tropical fruit and green peppers, whilst on the palate it displays ripe citrus fruit and melon characters.*



### 2 Chenin Blanc, Cape Bay Winery, 2008 South Africa

### 3 Sauvignon Blanc, The Jibe 2006/7 Marlborough, New Zealand

### 4 Chardonnay, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Fortant 2007 France

*Made by one of the pioneers of the French wine industry this is modern southern French wine making at its very best. A touch of oak balances out the white pear and ripe apple flavours. Ideal with seafood and white meats.*



### 5 Beronia Blanco, Gonzalez Byass 2007/8 Spain

*Delicate but vigorous, with good structure. To the palate, delightful and varied sensations of fresh fruit, notably quince and peach, with suggestions of fennel and medlar.*

### 6 Mâcon Lugny Les Genievres, Louis Latour, 2007 France

### 7 Unwooded Chardonnay, Katherine Hills, 2008 South Australia

*A lovely example of an unoaked Chardonnay from Australia. Still shows the ripe tropical fruit expected of a hot climate white but has a crisp and zingy edge to it that is often missing of other Chardonnays you may had previously.*

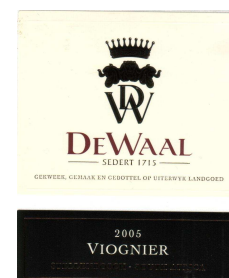


Soft, fruity White Wines

### 8 Pinot Grigio Ca'Lungnetta, IGT, Botter, 2007/8 Italy

£15.95

*The elegant bouquet displays hints of ripe fruits and flowers. The palate is dry, soft and well-balanced with a full bodied structure of ripe, refreshing fruit.*



### 9 Viognier, De Waal Estate, 2008 South Africa

£23.50

*A gold tint and rich viscosity. Creamy flavours of flowers, perfume, honey and spices. An oily mouth feel with a long persistent finish. Perfect to control the strong flavours of spicy meals.*

### 10 Rosada, Vina Real, 2007/8, Spain

*Rosé is becoming popular all year round and wines such as this are ideal as they are very food friendly. Packed with tangy summer fruit flavours it is perfect for lighter dishes particularly seafood.*



### 11 Katherine Hills Rosé, 2008 Echo Point, South Australia

*This wine has a vibrant pink colour, with aromas of glacé cherries and berry fruit. Fresh, lively, strawberry and cherry flavours, and a zesty finish.*

## Champagne

### 13 Champagne Mansard Brut, NV France

£40.00

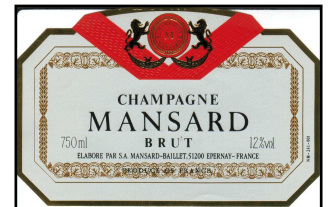
*Blended with the three main champagne grape varieties Pinot Noir gives elegance and length, Pinot Meunier gives body weight and Chardonnay contributes aroma and finesse. There is a good amount of bottle age on the brut non-vintage, making this a very enjoyable champagne.*



### 14 Moët et Chandon, NV France

£50.00

*Classic Champagne - blended from a third each of Pinot Noir, Pinot Meunier and Chardonnay. Matured for at least 3 years in bottle which helps give the wine its typical biscuity flavour.*



### 15 Veuve Clicquot, NV France

£60.00

*Well-known for both its full-bodied, biscuity style and its consistency, the success of this famous brand continues to grow and grow. A black grape dominated blend, using 70% Pinot Noir and Meunier together with 30% Chardonnay.*

### 16 Pinotage, Cape Bay Winery, 2007/8 South Africa

*From a grape variety unique to the Cape, this is a delicious red wine with attractive berry fruit.*

### 17 Pinot Noir, Louis Latour, 2007 France

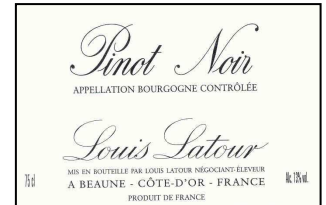
*An elegant, light bodied wine from Burgundy's classic red grape variety, full of soft, strawberry fruit flavours.*

Dry Red Wines

### 19 Chateau Leon, Premières Cotes de Bordeaux, 2004/6 France

*A delicious young claret, full of soft red fruit with good balance and length. This wine is only lightly filtered to retain the maximum flavour and should result in a light, harmless deposit in the bottom of the bottle.*

### 20 Chianti Classico, DOCG, San Leonino, 2005 Tenimenti Angelini, Italy

*A rich, ruby red wine that has been aged for 15 months in oak barrels to produce a dry and full-bodied wine.*

### 21 Chateau Carignan, 2002/4 Premières Cotes de Bordeaux, France

*Made of 70% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon and 10% Cabernet Franc this wine is aged for 18 months in 100% new barrels. Black garnet colour. The nose is very toasty with caramel and very ripe red berry fruit aromas. Licorice notes intensify the complexity.*

### 22 Beaune "Les Mariages" 2002, Domaine Rossignol-Trapet Bourgogne, France

*Named after a garden the newly wed couples of Beaune went to celebrate their Nuptials this Pinot Noir is soft silky and very elegant - a must with Duck but Perfect with poultry of any kind*

### 23 Larose de Gruaud Larose 2002 (second wine of Chateau Gruaud Larose), France

*This is a great example of a drinkable claret from a very high quality producer. It is made from the younger vines and is therefore slightly more forward and fruitier. Has a lovely pepper spice note to the palate that is ideal with red meat.*

### 24 Merlot, Torreon de Paredes, 2007 Chile

*This rich, ruby-red Merlot from Chile has the sweet vanilla aromas from ageing in oak barrels. It shows a good balance of fruit and tannin with a lovely, long finish.*

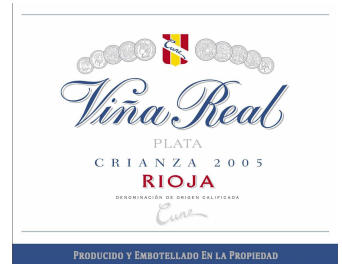

### **25 Rioja, Vina Real, Spain 2005**

**£19.95**

*1/2 Bottle* **£12.95**

*Fresh, fruity bouquet of soft red fruits with a touch of vanilla and spice. Pleasant fullness in the mouth with well-defined but silky tannins and a fleshy finish.*



### **26 Merlot, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Fortant, France, 2007**

**£14.95**

*Glass (125ml)* **£ 3.00**

*A merlot that is far too easy to drink! Ripe and juicy with a warm plum and bramble flavour. A great red for all through the meal but is particularly at home with roast poultry or cold meats*



### **27 Shiraz, South Australia, Katherine Hills, 2008, Australia**

**£17.95**

*Spicy, berry flavours complexed by a touch of mint, dominate this wine. The warm, ripe, savoury fruit results in a soft, rounded palate showing great length.*

### **28 Côtes du Rhône, Les Bastilles, France 2007**

**£16.95**

*Rich ruby colour with hints of purple. An intense fruity bouquet - red and black berries - with hints of spices and liquorice. An elegant and smooth flavour with a pleasant silky texture. This Côtes du Rhône is a good partner for grilled meat, poultry and game.*



### **29 Red Zinfandel, Woodbridge Winery, 2005/6 Robert Mondavi, USA**

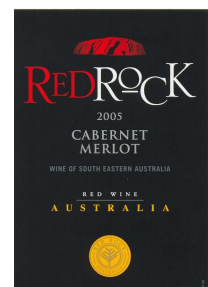
**£24.95**

*Our Zinfandel has a rich growing history in California and is excellent with robust entrees and cheeses.*

### **30 Cabernet/ Merlot, Red Rock 2006/7 Australia**

**£15.95**

*The wine displays intense fruit aromas of plum, blackcurrants and brambleberry fruit complimented by a soft sweet vanilla background. Soft tannins and well balanced acidity give good length and persistence of flavour.*
